



Applying for EAPL-S Awards

EAPL Gothenburg Conference, 2010

EAPL-S aims to provide students with mobility awards and conference incentives for each psychology and law related conference. The following awards were all generously donated by the EAPL for the 2009-2010 year, and will be awarded at the EAPL Gothenburg 2010 conference.

Eligibility:

You are eligible for these awards if you are.

- 1) A member of EAPL
- 2) Are registered as a student at a post-secondary institution
- 3) Are presenting a poster or paper at the EAPL 2010 conference.

Travel Awards

The EAPL-S is encouraging student conference attendance by providing one award to the student traveling the longest distance to the conference, one for the student with the highest GPA (each worth € 150) and one for the best research paper. You may only apply for one (1) of these awards.

Application: To apply for these awards provide proof of conference registration and EAPL membership and evidence that you have been accepted to present a poster or paper at the conference. You will also need to provide the following, depending on which award you are applying for:

- 1) Longest distance: Provide a Google maps route from your home address to the location of the conference. Include a copy/picture of your ID for proof of address.
- 2) Highest GPA: Provide your most recent transcript with GPA (if possible)
- 3) Research paper: Provide a summary of the paper that you are presenting at the conference. Max. 1000 words.

Deadline: Please submit all required materials by midnight (PST) June 6th, 2010 to eaplstudent@gmail.com

Best Student Poster Awards

For the three most outstanding and innovative posters submitted to the EAPL 2010 conference. First Place (€ 200), Second Place (€ 150), Third Place (€ 100).

Application: You are automatically entered in this competition if you are presenting a poster at the 2010 conference.

Evaluation: The awards committee will judge all posters during the EAPL 2010 poster session on Thursday, June 17th. The awards committee will be comprised of two EAPL student representatives and two EAPL professional representatives. Evaluation will be based on scoring criteria established ahead of time.

Award Ceremony: All travel awards will be presented during the EAPL conference dinner on June 16th.

Award recipients will receive a certificate and their monetary award at the dinner. The dinner is free of charge for registered conference guests. All student poster awards will be presented at the poster session on June 17th.
